

BRIEF FACTS ON THE UNIVERSITY MALAYA MEDICAL CENTRE (UMMC)



University Malaya Medical Centre (UMMC or University of Malaya Medical Centre) formerly known as University Hospital, is a government-funded medical institution located in Pantai Dalam, southwest corner of Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. It was established by Statute in September 1962 and is part of University of Malaya.

It serves as the teaching hospital for the Faculty of Medicine, University of Malaya and is the largest and oldest teaching hospital in Malaysia. The UMMC is also the second largest hospital in Malaysia.

University of Malaya Medical Centre, it has 1,617 beds which are distributed by 44 wards throughout the medical centre serving the district of Petaling.

In 2018, the number of patients receiving treatment from outpatient services recorded an increase from 1,024,169 patients in 2017 to 1,052,221 outpatients (2.74%) in 2018. Inpatient services also recorded an increase of 0.62% in 2018 with 55,245 patients receiving treatment as inpatients compared to 2017.
